DANGEROUS - DEADLY SPIDERS



WHITE TAIL

Found under bark, litter, crevices; outdoors and also indoors. Bite causes pain and ulceration to the skin.



RED BACK

Webs built in dry & sheltered areas, subfloors, garages, and around building materials



MALE FUNNEL-WEB



FEMALE FUNNEL-WEB

Found in dark, moist conditions

PAINFUL BITE - VENOMOUS SPIDERS



COMMON BLACK HOUSE SPIDER

Found in rock walls, tree trunks & crevices of window frames, guttering with funnel-like entrance



WOLF SPIDER

Union Jack on cephalothorax, ground dwelling.



MALE MOUSE SPIDER



FEMALE MOUSE SPIDER

Often mistaken for a funnel web. Ground dwelling. Fangs & head cephalothorax enlarged.

LOW RISK SPIDERS



GARDEN ORB WEAVER SPIDER

They're only a nuisance spider. Thick webs in the garden, beneficial.



ST. ANDREW'S CROSS

Nuisance spider.



HUNTSMAN

Lives under bark during daytime and often enters home.



MALE TRAP-



FEMALE TRAP-DOOR

Also mistaken for the Funnel Web Spider. Ground dwelling, often found in dry areas like lawns.
